

**Every good and perfect gift is from God our Father, who graciously provides for our every need**. This truth is reflected in Luther's Small Catechism in the explanation of the Apostles Creed:

I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still takes care of them. He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all I have. He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life. He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil. All this He does only out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him.

How is it that we "thank and praise, serve and obey Him"? The first line of LSB 781 sums it up well. "We give Thee but thine own, What-e'er the gift may be; All that we have is Thine alone, A trust, O Lord, from Thee."

In this annual season when we reflect on what the Lord has entrusted to us, **we respond in faith**: **Faith** in the One who gives, and **Faith**-*fully* in how we use what has been entrusted us for the mission and ministry of the church.
