August 13

(34) John 3:16 – God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

August 20

(104) Psalm 50:15 – Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me.

August 27

(111) Matthew 11:28 – Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

September 10

(169) Ephesians 4:32 – Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

September 17

(198) Matthew 7:12 – In everything, do to others what you would have them do to you.

(207) Luke 6:37 – Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned.

October 1

(224) Psalm 37:4 – Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart.

(232) Romans 6:23 – The wages of sin is death.

(242) Isaiah 64:6 – All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags.

(367) Psalm 145:15-16 – The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time. You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing.

(410) Colossians 2:9 – In Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form.

(440) 1 Corinthians 15:3 – Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures.

(556) 1 Corinthians 12:3 – No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.

December 10

(681) John 10:27-28 – My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.

December 17

(636) Ephesians 1:7 – In [Christ] we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.

(701) 1 John 5:14 – This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.

January 14

(764) Romans 8:28 – We know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

(789) Psalm 130:3-4 – If you, O LORD, kept a record of sins, O Lord, who could stand? But with you there is forgiveness; therefore, you are feared.

(853) Titus 3:5 – He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit.

February 18

(878) 1 John 1:8-9 – If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

(906) Ephesians 4:11 – It was [Christ] who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers.
