


AS WE GATHER

Throughout the Bible, we find God sculpting rocks, constructing with rocks, and protecting others by means of rocks. Ever the master architect, the Lord uses rocks to accomplish His purposes. More than that, the Lord Himself is our rock, the One in whom we have lasting and eternal security.

"Built on the Rock the Church shall stand," we sing (LSB 645:1). How do we stand? The prophet Isaiah tells us: "Look to the rock from which you were hewn" (Isaiah 51:1). 


HOLY GOSPEL - Matthew 16:13-20 - "On this rock I will build My church."


P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the sixteenth chapter.



For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. ¹⁸And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. ¹⁹I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." ²⁰Then he strictly charged the disciples to tell no one that he was the Christ.



For Guests and Visitors Desiring the Sacrament


