AS WE GATHER

Today's processional Gospel looks at the first day of Holy Week, and the Passion carries us on to Jesus' tomb. Throughout the entire week, and since His transfiguration, our Lord has moved toward the cross step by step. Despite opposition from crowds and His circle of friends, He has been determined to love us to death so that He might open heaven to us by the grace of God. Zechariah had written about the procession centuries earlier, and Paul proclaims that God the Father has exalted Jesus for His steadfast commitment to our salvation. But this is no mere history! We also are called to follow, to live through each day, step by step, faithful under various circumstances yet confident of mercy, grace, and forgiveness.

HOLY GOSPEL – John 12:12-19 – The triumphal entry

- The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the twelfth chapter. \mathbf{P}
- \mathbf{C} Glory to You, O Lord.
- P ¹² The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. ¹³ So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, crying out, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!" ¹⁴ And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written,

¹⁵ "Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!"

¹⁶ His disciples did not understand these things at first, but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written about him and had been done to him. 17 The crowd that had been with him when he called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to bear witness. ¹⁸ The reason why the crowd went to meet him was that they heard he had done this sign. ¹⁹ So the Pharisees said to one another, "You see that you are gaining nothing. Look, the world has gone after him."


P Let us go forth in peace, in the name of the Lord.

The cross leads the procession, followed by the choir (10:30am) and congregation walking two or three abreast down the center aisle, moving into pews toward the front of the nave.


How to make a Palm Cross

1. Hold the frond horizontally and fold in half.


2. Bend the right half straight up from the center to form a right angle.



3. Fold this same top strip, from the center, back and down, and then up and over again, to form a square at the back. It will still be a right angle at this point.



- 4. a) Bring the left strip **forward** and fold over the center towards the right.
- b) Fold away from you and pull through the square at back, all the way.

⁹Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he,

humble and mounted on a donkey,

on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

¹⁰I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim and the war horse from Jerusalem:

and the battle bow shall be cut off,

and he shall speak peace to the nations;

his rule shall be from sea to sea,

and from the River to the ends of the earth.

¹¹As for you also, because of the blood of my covenant with you, I will set your prisoners free from the waterless pit.

¹²Return to your stronghold, O prisoners of hope; today I declare that I will restore to you double.

GRADUAL – Hebrews 9:12, 15; Psalm 111:9

- A Christ entered once for all into the holy places, by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption. Therefore he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance.
- **C** He sent redemption to his people; he has commanded his covenant forever.

EPISTLE — **Philippians 2:5-11** — "At the name of Jesus every knee should bow."

⁵ Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. ⁸ And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. ⁹ Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.


5. Bend the top strip **forward** and put the end through the center square to make a shaft of desired length.




6. Fold **left** hand strip **backwards** and put through the back square. This makes the left crossbar and should be in proportion to the shaft.



7. Fold the **right** strip **back**, put through the back square and fasten.








I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.



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



Fulfilled is all that David told In true prophetic song of old; How God the nations' King should be, For God is reigning from the tree.


O tree of beauty, tree most fair, Ordained those holy limbs to bear; Gone is thy shame, each crimson'd bough Proclaims the King of glory now.

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


