



- If you desire to receive instruction for the Lord's Supper, please speak with one of our pastors.

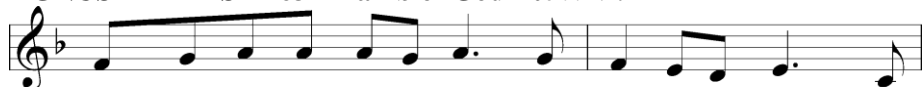

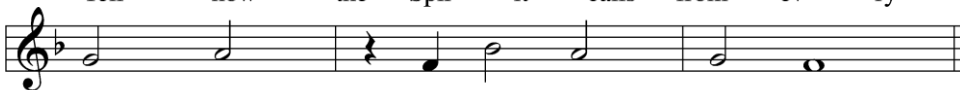
